




## Modern Day Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy Statement

Aran Services acknowledges the provisions of the Modern Day Slavery Act 2015. Aran Services also acknowledges that it is exempt from the “Transparency in Supply Chain” provisions to publish an annual statement as its annual turnover is not above the threshold (£36 million). However, Aran Services will ensure transparency within the organisation and with suppliers of goods and services to the organisation.

Aran Services is satisfied from its own due diligence that there is no evidence of any act of modern day slavery or human trafficking within the organisation or supply chain. As part of Aran Services due diligence process into slavery and human trafficking, Aran Services supplier approval process incorporates a review of the controls undertaken by the supplier.

Aran Services will not knowingly support or deal with any business involved in slavery or human trafficking.

Aran Services will undertake responsibility for implementing this Policy Statement and its objectives.
