### Section (B)

Living in a property with an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) rating of F or G.

**Or**

- Is aged 65 and over, or has a child under 5 or is pregnant.
- Is on the Energy Companies' Priority Services register.  
Has a health or vulnerability condition that can be exacerbated by living in a cold home, with confirmation from either one of the following: *letter from GP, hospital or other medical professional or an invitation for free flu jab for health reasons*
